
In 2022, we saw the completion of our new intensive care unit that expanded space by 28% and welcomed internal medicine residents to our graduate medical education program.

COVID-19

At Conway Regional, protecting the health and safety of our patients, employees, and community is our top priority. With the surge of the omicron variant in early 2022, Conway Regional expanded its drive thru COVID-19 testing capabilities and prioritized telemedicine appointments to continue to care for our patients, sick and well.

As part of our ongoing efforts to connect, inform, and update the community, we shared our inpatient COVID-19 census and the rate of unvaccinated COVID-19 hospitalizations on a weekly basis. Conway Regional continued to fight COVID-19 and saw the lift of the mask mandate at the end of 2022 for hospitals across the nation. This gave hope to our staff that COVID-19 was truly no longer a pandemic.

Growing Together

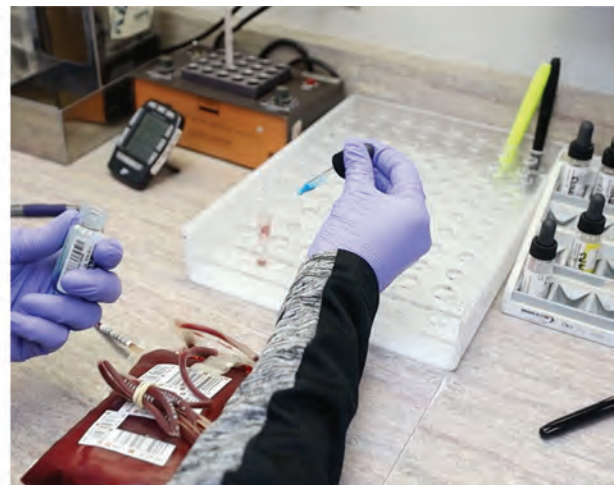
Intensive Care Unit

As the community grows, so does Conway Regional. Our new ICU, equipped with cutting-edge technology and thoughtfully designed facilities, is poised to transform the landscape of critical care. The new intensive care unit opened and saw its first patients in summer of 2022, expanding intensive care services to 24 critical care beds with room for future growth and expansion.

The atrium was constructed for patients, families, and staff to relax, meet, and eat. The atrium allows for natural light to infiltrate the space, with live plants and nature sounds to create a calming environment.

Laboratory Expansion

From the moment the Capital Campaign was initiated, it became clear that the vision of an expanded lab, and the transformative impact it would have on Conway Regional, had to be an integral part of this endeavor. The laboratory expansion made Conway Regional's chemistry track one of the most advanced in the state. The automation increased testing capacity from roughly 1,500 tests per hour to around 2,600 per hour (in total) or an increase of about 70%. The Conway Regional Laboratory serves all our primary care clinics, specialty clinics, inpatients, and more.



Graduate Medical Education

In 2022, Conway Regional Health System welcomed four new family medicine residents and five internal medicine residents. Family medicine residents include Taylor Dilday, MD, Payton Hartman, DO, Gregory Kwon, DO, and Trey McClain, MD. The inaugural class of internal medicine residents include Mallory Bagwell, DO, Alex He, DO, Ebrahim Karimjee, DO, Sohaib Rana, MD, and Nelson Tabe, MD. Graduate medical education at Conway Regional will help address the local physician shortage by training a generation of physicians who are critical thinkers, compassionate providers, skilled clinicians, and future leaders in medicine. Our dynamic education process encourages innovation while incorporating traditional family medicine, internal medicine, minor surgeries obstetrical/gynecological care, and pediatrics.



Rural Training Residency Track

In 2022, Conway Regional Health System received accreditation for a Rural Training Residency Track. Residents in this program will spend 51% of their time in residency practicing, learning, and growing their skills at Dardanelle Regional Medical Center. These residents will be a critical part of expanding access to compassionate, high-quality health care to all communities. Under the leadership of program director Sarah Robertson, MD, associate Program director Hailey Farris, MD, and multiple staff and faculty members, the residents will receive a well-rounded residency experience through a wide range of rotations and experiences.
