



2020 Tournament Rules

TEAMS

- Teams cannot exceed four hunters. Hosts may join the hunt with priority given to the team members.

LIMITS

- Six (6) duck limit per Arkansas Game and Fish rules/regulations.
- All ducks must be retrieved, counted and all birds must be checked, 100% fair chase.

CALL-IN / CHECK-IN

- Teams must call in their harvest to Arkansas Duck Derby committee by 11:30am (501-733-4544).
- Check-in with ducks at C2 Powersports (650 Dave Ward Drive, Conway, AR) by 1 pm.
- Species/sex point values will be randomly assigned at 1:15 pm.

SCORING

- All ducks harvested will be segregated by species and sex and scored as follows:
 - Each species including drakes and hens will be displayed on score board.
 - Scores for each species and sex will be randomly assigned.
 - Team scores will be determined by birds “in their bag”, segregated by the number harvested by species and sex multiplied by the assigned value for each species and sex and then totaled.
- Team with the most points will be awarded as the Winner.
- In the event of a tie, the team with the earliest recorded call-in will be the Winner.
- Prizes will be awarded to the 2nd and 3rd place teams using the same system.
